ORDER

Sub: Office of the Regional Administrator, Mahe – Outbreak of
NIPAH virus in some parts of Kozhikode Districts of
Kerala State – relaxation of restrictions issued and
reopening of schools/colleges – Orders – Issued.

It is informed that the recent NIPAH outbreak in Kozhikode District is under control and no positive case reported in the recent days. Hence it has been decided to relax the restrictions issued and reopen the school/colleges of Mahe region. Now therefore it is ordered that:-

- All schools and colleges including professional colleges of Mahe region shall function with effect from 25-09-2023. 06 days compensatory classes shall be conducted in all the Government Schools/Colleges of Mahe region on alternate Saturdays. (Action: CEO, Mahe and all head of Educational Institutions)
- All Anganwadis and Madrasas shall function with effect from 25-09-2023.
- All tuition centres and coaching centres shall function with effect from 25-09-2023.
- Indoor Stadium, Mahe shall function with effect from 25-09-2023.
- People shall continue to wear mask in public places/markets/shops without fail.
- Restriction on number of attendees in meeting/function and religious institutions is withdrawn.
