

10. Students with less than 75% attendance are not eligible to appear for the university examinations. They have to redo the semester in the next academic year after obtaining necessary permission from the university.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- The college is a sacred institution and every student should be on alert to ensure that he/she
 does not take part in any activity that may tarnish the reputation of the college or jeopardize
 its security. His/her motto should be to work tirelessly for the progress, prosperity and
- its security. His/her motto should be to work tirelessly for the progress, prosperity and prestige of the college.

 2. Except the classroom, veranda, corridors and the immediate adjoining areas, canteen and the playground, students shall under no circumstance enter any other area in the college campus without the special permission of the principal. They should not assemble in the vehicle parking area or sit on the steps grills.

 3. Students are permitted inside the canteen only during lunch time.

 4. Students should not, in any way destroy, damage or misuse the plants and trees in and around the college campus.

 5. Students are to wear neat and befitting dress.

 6. When a member of staff or any visitor enters the class room, students shall stand up as a mark of respect.

- 7. No student shall enter or leave a class without the permission of or instruction from the
- teacher concerned.

 8. Students shall move from one class to another in an orderly and disciplined manner without ausing any disturbance to other classes.
- During the working hours, students shall not loiter about, make noise or disturb classes in
 any way. If a particular class becomes free, they have to go to the library/reading room.
 Students are forbidden from keeping or consuming liquor, intoxicating drinks or narcotics.
 If anybody is found in possession of the same, severe action will be taken against them. It will be treated as crime and dealt with as "Law and Order" problems by competent
- authorities.

 II. Vehicles should be parked in the parking area only. Students using vehicles should hand over a copy of the driving license and the RC book of the vehicle to the head of department.

 12. No student shall misplace, dislocate or tamper with any furniture or equipment. Deliberate vandalisma and wiful damage will be viewed very seriously and the gullty will have to pay fine imposed by the principal on the recommendation of the College Council.

 13. It shall be the duty of every student to keep the college and the campus neat and clean.

 15. The movements of the students in the college premises shall conform to standards of academic decency decourage and disnity.

 16. Students shall desist from demonstrations and campaigning which may tend to disturb work in the classes. However, demonstrations and campaigns may be conducted during such time as may be decided after discussion between the principal and the representatives of tudent organization.
- Demonstrations and campaigns, if at all necessary, must be conducted exercising utmost self-control so that political, social, communal and personal sensibilities are neither wounded nor insulted.
- 18. Armed demonstrations and confrontations with or without arms are strictly forbidden. Such activities will be deemed criminal and dealt with as "Law and Order" problems by competent authorities

- Exhibiting posters and writings on or disfiguring the walls in the college campus are strictly forbidden.
- 20. Notices relating to Registered Students' Organisations shall be displayed only on the notice
- boards specially earmarked by the principal for the purpose.

 21. Every student is expected to provide himself herself the necessary text books.

 22. Every student must obey the teachers and respectfully carry out their instructions. The students shall observe politeness towards the non-teaching staff of the college and behave
- decorously with his/her fellow students.

 23. Students are prohibited from organising any meeting or entertainments in the college or collecting money for any purposes without the permission of the principal.

 2.4 Students guilty of going over to other colleges and institutions to take part in act of indiscipline such as organizing demonstrations and strikes would be deemed especially culpable and would be punished accordingly.

 2.5 Students shall not hold meeting for criticizing the conduct of the university or the college authorities. Such meeting shall be deemed unlawful and the principal may take such action as he deems necessary to prohibit or to punish and in case he considers it very serious, to report to the University for rustications.

 2.6 Teasing, ragging etc, are punishable offences, to the extent of summary expulsion from the college.
- 27. The name of the college or its authorities shall not be used in any publications or in any
- manner without the permission of the principal.

 28. No class or group of students should engage themselves in any public activity, even on purely social nature, without the principal's permission.

 29. Students who do not abide by the above instructions are liable to be punished by the
- principal.

 30. The principal may impose the following punishments pursuant to the decision taken by the college council Fines, withholding of term certificates, forfeiture of educational concessions and scholarships, suspension and expulsion.
- 31. However serious the problems might be, these are to be sorted out through peaceful and useful negotiations and discussions and students shall not boycott the classes and resort to strikes which paralyze the effective functioning of the college and is detrimental to the students.

RULES FOR LAB SESSIONS

- Students are not to enter Laboratory in the absence of a staff member. Instructions of the staff members should be strictly followed inside the lab.
- They must bring their observation note books to the practical sessions and submit their fair record regularly on the stipulated dates. Failing to do so may entail his/her losing the day's practical work.
- 4. Students who fail to perform the required number of experiments will not be allowed to attend the university examinations

RULES OF DISCIPLINE

The Principal of the college shall have complete authority for the maintenance of discipline
of the students of the college. He may frame and issue from time-to-time disciplinary
rules of a temporary or permanent character, regulating the conduct of the students within
the campus or outside the college.



RAGGING AND REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING AS PER THE 2009 UGCGUIDELINES

I What is Ragging?

- Any rude word or deed that causes annoyance, hardship or physical or psychological harm to any other student
- · Raising fear or apprehension in a fresher, junior or any student
- · Fereing a student to do anything that will cause shame or embarrassment
- In Julging in any undisciplined activity that adversely affects the physique or psyche of a student

II Undertaking by Student

I AMARA S.P. S.O. D.O. of Mr./Mrs./Ms. ANILKOMPR.k.Phave carefully read and fully understood the law prohibiting ragging and the directions of the Supreme Court and the Central/State Government in the regard. I have received a copy of the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions. 2009. and have carefully gone through it. I hereby undertake that

- I will not include in any behavior or act that may come under the definition of ragging


